

Trip to Documenta 14 in Kassel, Germany

19 - 21 June 2017

A comprehensive and influential survey of contemporary art, Documenta takes place only once every five years in the small German town of Kassel. All media and all types of artists are represented making it an excellent resource for both the collector and for research purposes.

Documenta was established in 1955 as the first exhibition of contemporary art in Germany since the fall of Nazism, and marked the start of a new era in the cultural history of the country. Seven decades later, the exhibition is no longer a showcase of the 'best' artistic achievements in the West, rather, it serves as a 'think-tank' for the international art community, and an opportunity to reflect and consider in depth new developments in the world around us.

During the trip we will explore the highlights of the exhibition along with many site-specific works that traditionally form the major part of the show, discovering the artists' take on the present, and their vision of the future.

Participation fee includes bespoke itinerary and commentary, but excludes travel and accommodation.
